Notification of Acceptance: March 17, 2025.

Text Formatting: MS Word, TNR 12pt, single-spaced, 'normal' margins, no auto-formatting

Content Order: Name, institution, abstract, up to 5 keywords, 3-5 items of indicative bibliography
